The school will work where possible to implement and maintain Fair Trade options in, but not limited to, the dining facilities, catered events, school offices and the school store. These efforts will be led by the Fair Trade Committee comprised of members of the student body, faculty, staff, and dining service. In support of this resolution are the attached documents.
